



CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Please treat the Club as you would your own property and take responsibility to ensure its continued success.
2. Good manners should be practiced at all times. Members should behave with courtesy and consideration towards other players, on the courts/course, in and around the clubhouse, and in message groups.
3. All non-members must pay the appropriate green-fees **and** enter their names in the sign-in book. Non-members must ensure they have a court booking, or that the course is open, before paying. No refunds will be given.
4. All applicable fees must be paid **before** commencing play – green-fees, light charges, ball purchase etc.

TENNIS COURTS

5. Please do not enter a court when a game is in progress if it is likely to cause interference or distraction. Only do so when play has temporarily stopped.
6. If you need to cross a court that is occupied to access yours, please only cross in between points. Access to courts 4, 5 & 6 should be made via the lower gate to ensure crossing courts is kept to a minimum.
7. During play, if a ball of yours strays onto or behind another court, do not attempt to retrieve the ball if there is a game in progress on that court. Wait until the point on the adjoining court is finished before you retrieve the ball.
8. While a game is in progress, please do not make excessive noise while in the vicinity of that court out of respect to the players.
9. Preference for court time/use will be given to members over non- members.
10. When tennis courts are booked but not occupied, a grace period of 15 minutes should be allowed after which the courts may be taken on a first come first served basis.
11. After 8.00 pm no singles play will be allowed if all courts are occupied and there are members waiting to play (doubles only).

12. Court time is to be restricted to 1 hour if all courts are in use and members are waiting to play (doubles).
13. Proper tennis shoes only to be worn on the courts.
14. Please don't leave rubbish on the courts.

PITCH & PUTT COURSE

15. Players to play from the Tee-Boxes provided, and in a maximum group of four.
16. Players to always wait until the course ahead is clear.
17. Slow players will invite faster players through.
18. Players will replace divots and repair plug marks. Pitch mark repairers are compulsory for all members.
19. Players will not use a wedge on the green.
20. Players will not use wooden tees.
21. Players will comply with P&P Ireland dress code for championships.
22. Players will wear appropriate footwear.
23. Players shall refrain from shouting except in the case of a wayward shot in which case this player should shout 'fore' to alert endangered players.
24. Players shall abide by management decisions concerning the course and the facilities.
